

GOVERNMENT OF BRITISH COLUMBIA.

IMPORTANT.

TO THE REGISTERED OWNER:

Enclosed for your convenience are application forms for licence for motor-vehicle registered in your name for the licence-year ending February 28th, 1935.

LICENCES MAY BE PROCURED IN EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING WAYS:—

1. Present complete form signed, together with fee, at nearest issuing office.
2. Mail complete form signed to Commissioner, B.C. Police (Motor Branch), Victoria, B.C., together with fee, and ADDITIONAL SUM OF 15 CENTS to cover postage on plates, and plates and licence will be sent you by return mail.

If additional sum of 15 cents to cover postage is not included in remittance, number-plates will be forwarded by express collect without further notice.

PLEASE DO NOT detach any portion of form or alter or change form in any particular, as same will not be accepted incomplete or altered in any way.

FEE shown is for full year. If renewal taken out on or after April 1st, deduct $\frac{1}{12}$ th; on or after May 1st, deduct $\frac{2}{12}$ ths; on or after June 1st, deduct $\frac{3}{12}$ ths, etc.—a monthly reduction of $\frac{1}{12}$ th for each month. Minimum fee, \$2.

Owing to the fact that there is a monthly reduction allowed on motor-vehicle licences no extension of time can be allowed in the operation of motor-vehicles without their licences for the new year, and persons operating or using their motor-vehicles on or after March 1st, 1934, without 1934 licences will be subject to prosecution. In order to save yourself delay it is requested that application for 1934 licence be made as early as possible in February, 1934.

MOTOR-VEHICLE LICENCES FOR MONTHS OF JANUARY AND FEBRUARY, 1934.

For those registered owners of motor-vehicles for which the annual licence fee for 1933 has been paid in full on or before March 1st, 1933, a wind-shield sticker is enclosed which should be mounted on the inside lower right-hand corner of the wind-shield. The 1933 licences of all motor-vehicles carrying 1933 licences and plates issued for them, and wind-shield stickers as above, are extended to midnight on February 28th, 1934.

Registered owners of motor-vehicles for which the annual licence fee for 1933 has not been paid in full on or before March 1st, 1933, may, by making application to the nearest issuing office or this office, and paying a fee equal to one-sixth of the annual licence fee for 1933 for such motor-vehicle, obtain a wind-shield sticker extension licence, extending their 1933 motor-vehicle licence until February 28th, 1934.

PLEASE NOTE.—If your address is not as stated, please give new address in space provided.

Renewal of licence for 1934 may only be obtained by use of enclosed form. If information given on form is incorrect, return same to this office, giving correct particulars.

If you do not wish to use the attached form until later on in the year, put it away carefully, so that you may have it when making application for 1934 licence, and save yourself any inconvenience or delay which may be caused you through inability to produce the form.

If you have disposed of motor-vehicle referred to in enclosed application, the same is still registered in your name, and for your own protection a Notice of Transfer should immediately be put through from yourself to the new owner, which can be done by applying to the nearest issuing office. New owner cannot obtain 1934 licence for this car until it is transferred into his name.

Should you dispose of motor-vehicle referred to in enclosed application after receipt of same, kindly return this form to me, and at the same time see that such motor-vehicle is properly transferred from yourself to the new owner.

DRIVER'S LICENCE.

All 1933 drivers' licences, chauffeurs' licences, and motor-salesmen's licences have been extended to February 28th, 1934.

For your convenience I am enclosing forms of application for renewal of your driver's licence for the licence-year ending February 28th, 1935. In order to save delay at the issuing office, I would suggest that these forms be filled in (in triplicate) before attending at the issuing office.
